

Strategic Leadership Table Membership - Sector Representation for Children and Youth Services

Membership will be from cross-sectoral organizations who provide services for children, youth and their families in the City of Brantford, the County of Brant, Six Nations of the Grand River, and Mississaugas of the Credit First Nation. Each organization's representative will have enough authority to commit resources as well as sufficient knowledge to understand the operational details and impact of changes. There will be a minimum of 10 and maximum of 20 members. There will be an annual evaluation of the membership. At a minimum, the membership includes services from the following areas.
