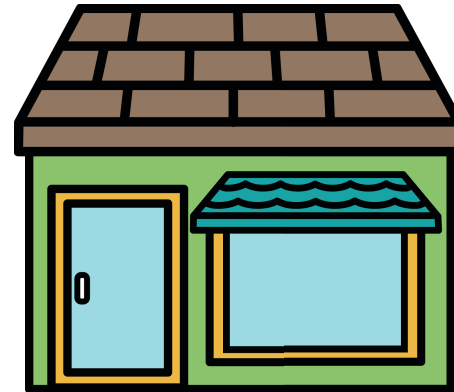


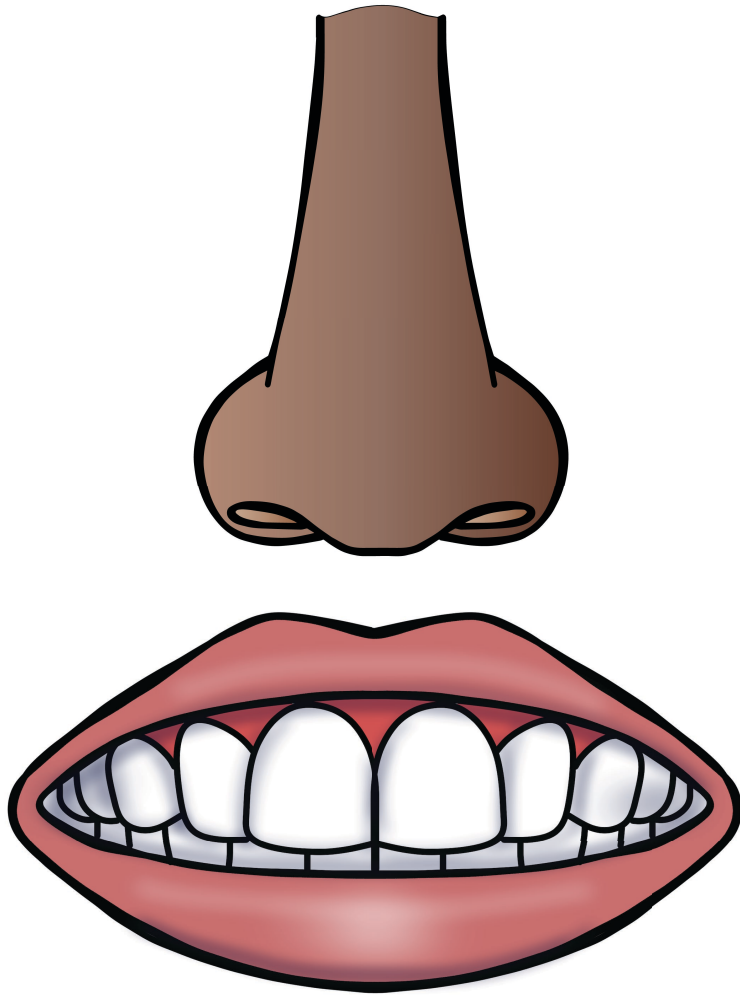
Why does my therapist look different?



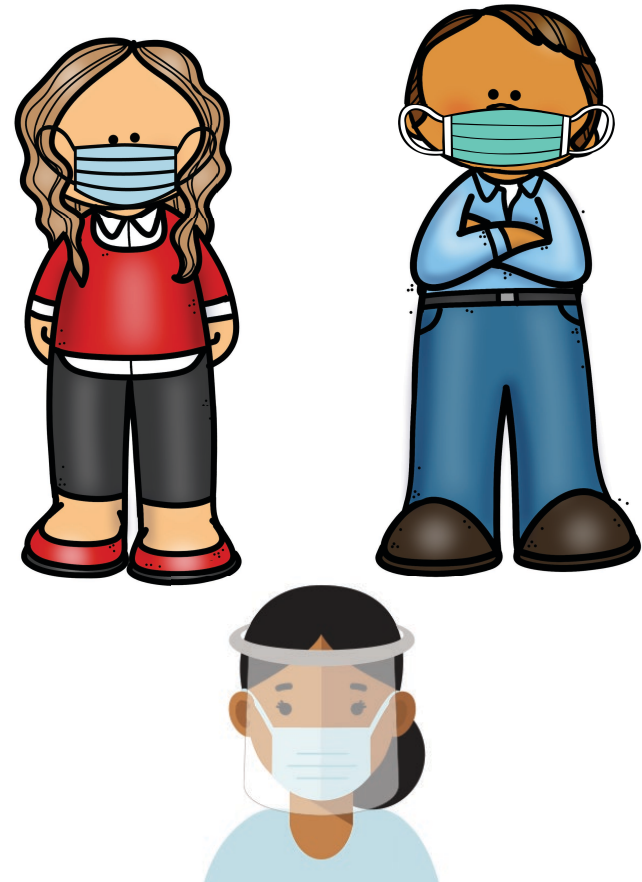
A Story for Children



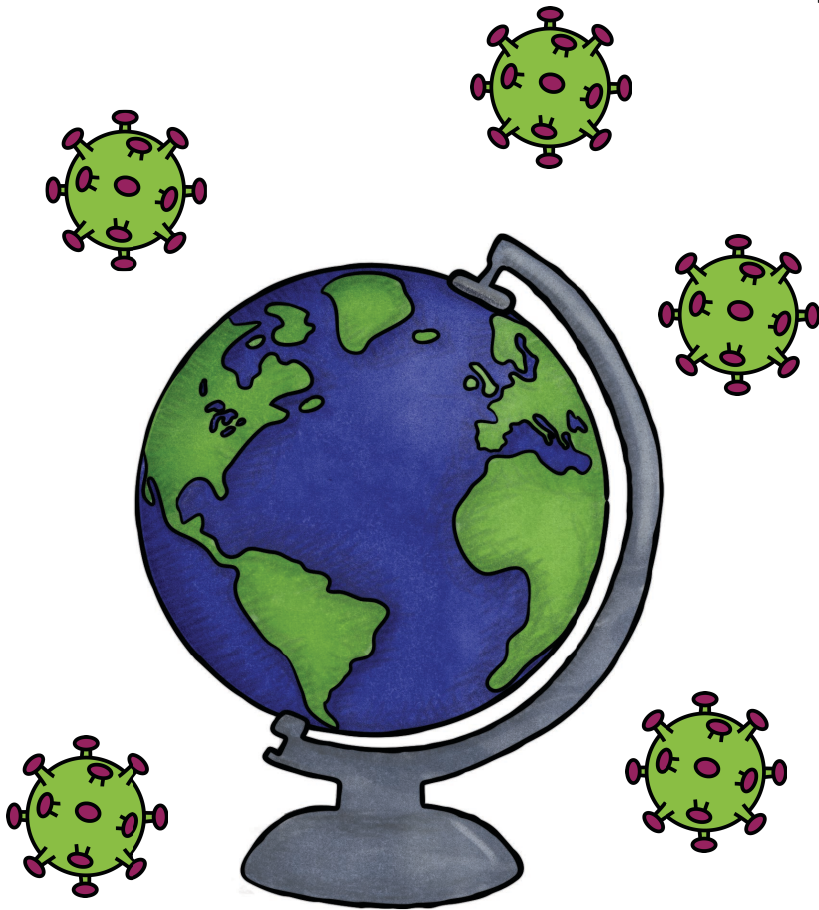
I have an appointment
with my therapist.



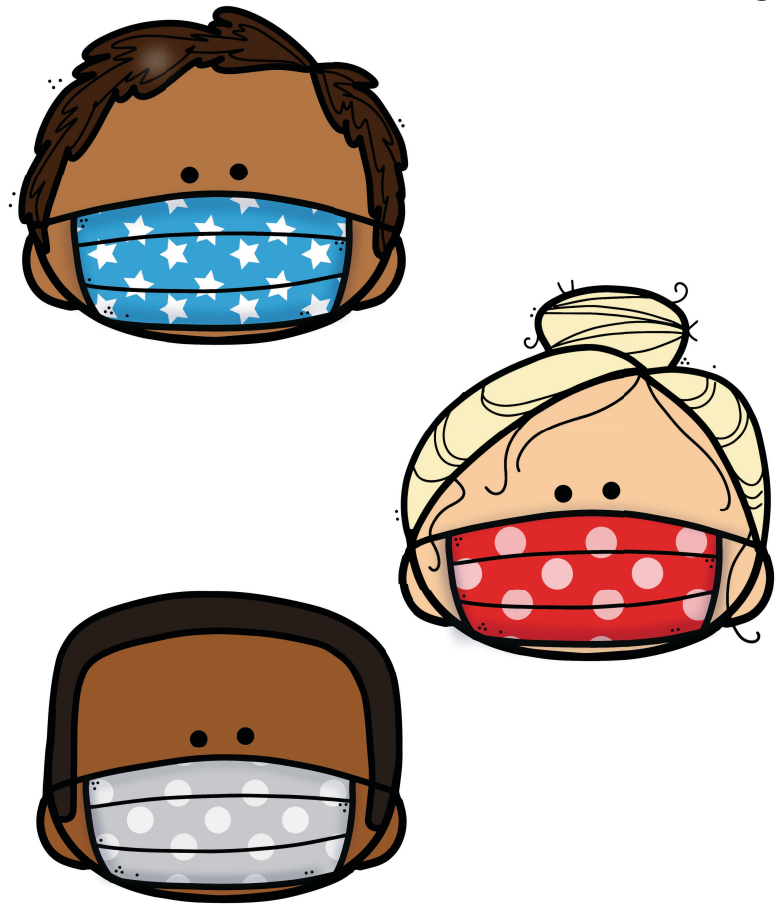
Usually I can see my social therapist's nose and mouth.



But now, my therapist must wear a mask. The mask covers his or her nose and mouth. They might even be wearing a face shield



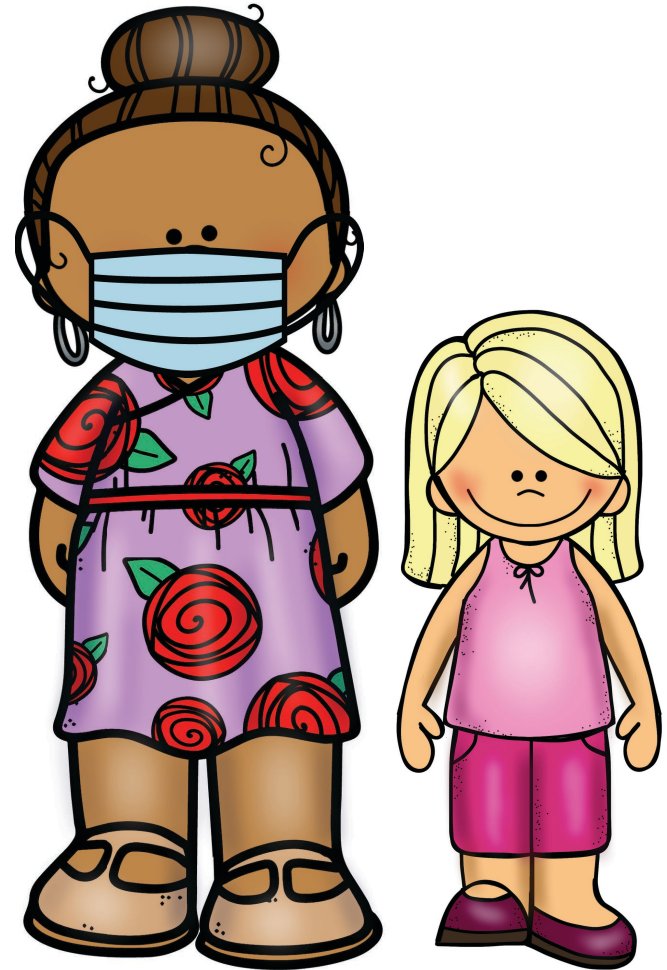
There a virus called

some people get sick.



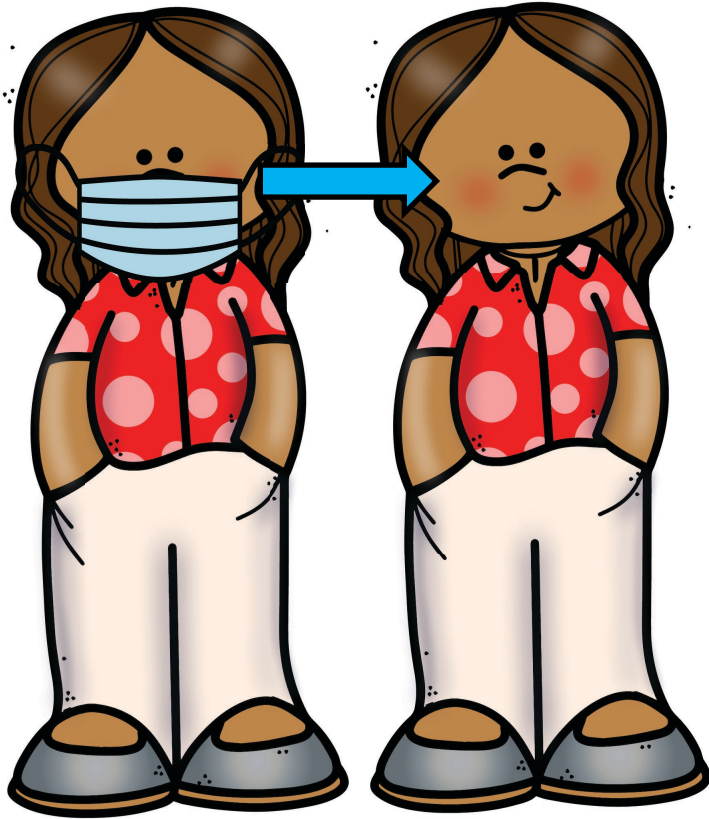
I've probably seen a lot of

therapist wearing a mask.



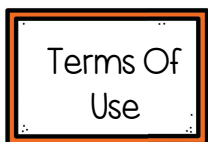
But, we will both get used to it!
