Message from the Board Chair and CEO

2021 – 2022 was a year of significant growth for our organization. Contact Brant was named the Lead Organization for the Ontario Autism Program's Urgent Response Service for the Hamilton-Niagara Region. Our staff team increased from 13 to 18 with the implementation of this service. We are grateful to the Coordinating Agencies in West Region, as well as other service providers, who have supported the planning and implementation of this new service.

For almost ten years, Contact Brant has flagged the need for an additional Resource Coordinator to support our Access mandate. Twenty years ago we were serving approximately 860 annually with same four Resource Coordinators. In 2021/2022, we served 4,088 unique individuals with the same level of staffing. With new funding received from the Ministry of Health to specifically address the increased demand for services, we were able to realign job responsibilities and changed our Assistant Resource Coordinator to a Resource Coordinator position. We now have five Resource Coordinators serving the Brant community.

The pandemic informed us of the benefits of a hybrid model with some staff working from home and some working in the office. We have not expanded our footprint with the increased staffing, enabling us to focus resources on services as well as increase staff satisfaction with options for work. Most importantly, children, youth, and families continue to primarily state their preference for virtual intake meetings and often choose virtual case conferencing.

We continue to provide flexible and responsive services based on the unique needs of each child, youth, and family.

Coordinated Supports



Contact Brant is the lead agency for Coordinated Service Planning in Brant and works with community organizations, education, and health services to ensure services are wrapped around a family with a single plan of care.



Contact Brant provides Service Coordination support to families of children and youth who have FASD, or suspected FASD. We provide educational opportunities for caregivers and professionals, and support the Brant FASD Caregiver Group.

URS Ontario Autism Program: **Urgent Response Service**

Contact Brant is the Lead Organization for the Urgent Response Service (URS) in the Hamilton-Niagara Region. Working with the family and community services, Contact Brant develops short-term services and supports to respond rapidly to the specific high-risk need to reduce the risk of harm to the child/youth, others, or property.

Case Resolution, RPAC and TAY

Contact Brant facilitates the community Case Resolution Mechanism to address children and youth with complex special needs, as well as RPAC (Residential Placement Advisory Committee). Contact Brant works collaboratively with community partners to integrate Transition Planning for youth with a developmental disability.


